TOPICS for DISCUSSION:

- 1. <u>Constitution and By-Law updates:</u> Dept AG is reviewing. Dale was able to talk with him.
- 2. <u>Budget for 2019-2020:</u> Finalize and inform membership
 - a. Officers present reviewed latest budget with Commander. Light discussion ensued.
 - i. Oratorical contest funds would be to get a program started if it happens
 - ii. Budget for storage unit is for a larger, more expensive unit
 - iii. Possible additional expense item: The giving of \$25 gift cards to any NHBS senior who is planning to go into the military after graduation along with a certificate
 - b. Budget slides used will be shown to membership next week
- 3. <u>Elections:</u> Completed. Officers to be installed in June using short-form from Officers Guide
 - a. Need to review process with Sgt at Arms & Commander & Chaplain (Page 56)
 - i. Gave printout of short form installation to Bill Smith as he has a speaking part
- 4. <u>Historian:</u> John Larkin has stepped up to take on Historian position. He will be appointed and later on in year, elected into position. Dan Dodge to perform turnover.
- 5. <u>Color Guard status:</u> Dale to talk with Alan Simmons to get Color Guard moving again to be used for July 4th parade
- 6. <u>Scholarships: boys and girls state status:</u> One of the girls did not go. Rick and Dale working with Col Baker on the situation. 2 boys go next week. Rick working with them to ensure they are prepared
- 7. Officers guide to all officers + Roberts Rules

8. <u>Phone Tree</u> – Part of Emergency OPS plan action plan: Dan demo'd a concept. Dale indicated the list could have multiple uses: 1) for disaster planning and alerting of members and 2) for buddy calls. Dan to write up a procedure for calling, reporting, etc.

Note: Dale has also performed a Readiness Assessment using a form from the Red Cross

9. Town of Bellville Veterans Memorial at Riverwalk Park – Give a brick: We discussed several options. Dale indicated that next year, the Town of Leland will be putting in their own memorial park. The conscientious was that we ask the membership to purchase 1 brick for the Belville park for the Post. Cost is \$50 and includes clip-art (orders to be taken until end of Dec 2019). After Leland completes their park, we revisit this and look at individual bricks for deceased members including PFC Jacobs. Other names include: Carshaw, Jacobs, Welsh + any other deceased members since 2014.

Imprint would be in black only and would have new Post name if approved



- 10. Getting more interaction from membership at meetings.
 - a. How to induce more discussion: Dale indicated we would have to cut down on the amount of material in the meeting agenda. Any "for your info" could be put into minutes or a newsletter to the membership
 - b. Possibly highlight 1 member each meeting
 - c. John brought up idea of a pot-luck dinner with members and spouses as just a social event. Possibly at the Commons. Maybe using grill. We will pursue this idea

- 11. <u>Flag for John Cook's cemetery:</u> John's cemetery flag pole has no flag. Dale asked about the Post purchasing one for him. Several officers spoke up that they have extra flags they would be willing to donate (Jim, Dan F., John). Dale to talk with John Cook about the size needed.
- 12. <u>Habitat for Humanity</u> now a Veteran's affiliate for home restoration and repair
 - a. Post member Veronica Carter involved
 - b. Clinic for people (including vets) who have had problems with unscrupulous contractors
 - c. Dan to send note to Veronica asking her to let us know when they are ready.
 - d. Dale has sent into to Lane as Service Officer
- 13. <u>Membership year pins:</u> Dale has talked with other Posts who hold annual "Pinning" ceremonies to present membership pins to those members who reach various continuous year milestones. Pins cost about \$9.00 each. However there is a less expensive pin available for 5 years. Officers present voted YES (unanimous) to do this. It is another way to recognize our members
 - a. Getting members caught up? No. We would only present a single pin to a member as they reach a milestone. We would look to see who hit a milestone during a predetermined milestone. Ie: July of 2018 to June of 2019
 - b. Possibly FALL time-frame?
 - c. Dan to produce listing of members who have hit any 5 year milestone from July 2018 to June of 2019


- a. New membership slide items: Will be taking extracts from monthly Dept. bulletins that would be of interest to members
