2019 Department Convention Voting

Chairmen of post delegations should check with the Headquarters staff at the Convention Registration Desk at the North Raleigh Hilton upon arrival in Raleigh to be sure that their Post delegates are properly certified. In accordance with Article V Section 9 of the Department Constitution and By-Laws, only those Posts whose delegates are duly certified and whose registration fee has been paid will be permitted to vote in the Department elections. The pre-registration fee is \$5.00 per delegate. Registration at the Convention will be \$7.00 per delegate. Certification for delegates must be received at headquarters no later than <u>May 27, 2019</u>.

In order to do this, it is imperative we get the Commander and Adjutant packets and 2020 membership cards into the proper hands as soon as possible. Nothing is automatic, so you must mail the form. **\$5,000** in accidental Death coverage for covered accidents that occur if you are traveling on official Legion business. **\$1000.00** for all other covered accidents. 24/7 protection that covers Legionnaires at home, work or while they are traveling away from home. This is available to all "**current**" Legion members. This is one thing that you just do not want to "put off".

Ronald McDonald Houses

This is a reminder to bring in your Aluminum Pull Tabs for the NC Ronald McDonald Houses. Your donations are very important to the families that stay at the Ronald McDonald Houses while their child or children are going through cancer treatments.
