Old Business

- Lane Adrian gave a report on the upcoming Veterans Action Benefit Center (VBAC). We expect to serve 1,000 2,000 veterans. The Veterans Administration is sending people down as well as from Winston-Salem.
- We are competing with other charities to sell wrist bands at the Wilmington Downtown Summer Concert Series. Information is on our web site.

New Business

- Veteran in Need. Dale Todd, our new Service Officer, gave a report on a Navy veteran who needs help (Anita Hartsell from the County Veterans Services Office reached out to us). After reviewing his financial situation and discussions with the veteran, the Post agreed to pay one of his co-pays that he owes to the VA. For short term relief, we also agreed to provide him with a gift card that could be used to purchase food. Both Dale and our Chaplain will meet with the veteran at his home. Greg Miller suggested that we see if he needs help with finances and planning and to see if the senior center can help in some way. John Cook also said that his church also might be able to help. (Eric Mens, a Post member and recently appointed Director on the Board of Brunswick Family Assistance (BFA), asked BFA to interview the veteran to determine eligibility for longer term potential assistance with rent, utility payments, food needs, and budgeting/financial planning. That process is currently ongoing).
- <u>Flag Retirement</u>. Bobby Hunt's report on flag burning ceremony: We are collecting unserviceable flags April 22nd at the Brunswick Forest Commons. Information will be posted on Brunswick Forest Next Door as well as local television and radio media. The event will run from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. If we get enough donations and it seems to be on track we'll also sell some burgers or hot dogs. Near the end of June, we'll have the flag burning ceremony. Boy Scouts may assist in the ceremony.
