Discrepancy still between what our Post financial and membership records show versus what State and National records show concerning active paid members due to at least a 3-week time lag.

**National roster** shows 100 active (2016 & 2017) members - Includes 3 members who resigned or moved in 2016

**Our records** show 100 active (2016 & 2017) members - Includes 3 members who are not on the National Roster (one paid up for 2017, two paid up only through 2016)

17 of our members have not yet paid 2017 dues.

- Color Guard

  - Need another 1-3 volunteers (sign-up sheet)
  - Uniforms need to be determined fatigues and boots or Navy Blue Trousers, White Collared Shirt, and Black Dress Shoes
  - Costs not yet determined
  - o JROTC First Sergeant George Williams will train the Color Guard

- Spousal Support Group
  - January 2017 Meeting was cancelled
  - o To date, the Spousal Support Group has raised and donated over \$900 to the Post General Fund
- Status of Boys State and Girls State leadership programs
  - o Boys State Rick de Moya is the Post Lead
    - Still waiting for complete 2017 information packet
    - Rick de Moya and Bill Kous will review applications and interview candidates
    - May 1<sup>st</sup> deadline for nominations
    - Last year cost \$350 Post may offer to pay partial or full cost dependent upon student's financial need
    - Officers voted to send two students one from JROTC and one from the general school population
  - O Girls State Current American Legion Bylaws do not allow Posts to send a girl to Girls State if the Post does not have an Auxiliary.
    - The American Legion Bylaws do not reflect current mores.
    - Mary Skov has volunteered to prepare a proposal to amend the National Bylaws to permit girls to be nominated to and attend Girls State.
