Guest Speaker: Fred Roche, Administrator, Veterans Affairs (VA) Health Care Center (HCC), Wilmington; accompanied by Tyra Hoffman, VA Volunteer Services Specialist

Mr. Roche discussed several issues related to the HCC, the VA in general, addressed questions from the audience, and made himself available after the meeting to address member's concerns one-on-one. Highlights included:

- Potential privatization of VA health services remains a significant concern.
- The Choice program is still experiencing significant contractor performance as well as payment issues.
- Safe drinking water issues still exist at the Wilmington HCC.
- A third Audiology Booth has been added to the Wilmington HCC to address significant need. You do not need a referral from a primary care doctor to get an audiology appointment.
- Veterans are encouraged to use Secure Messaging as a means to communicate their medical needs and concerns to the VA staff. (Currently, veterans need to be authenticated for Secure Messaging on site at the HCC. Starting

- in January 2017, onsite authentication will no longer be required. Volunteers at the HCC can help veterans establish a Secure Messaging account.)
- HCC only handle initial or emergency prescription needs. After that, prescriptions are filled through the mail fulfillment center in Charleston, SC.

The Acting Commander, Eric Mens, presented Mr. Roche with a Post 68 baseball cap in thanks for his presentation.

Old Business:
