Current Business:

<u>Approval of prior meeting minutes</u>: Motion made, seconded and passed by vote of membership present to approve meeting minutes of prior month's membership meeting as published.

<u>Guest Speakers</u>: Our first guest speaker for the evening – Tierian "Randy" Cash – Department of NC Adjutant. Introduction by Dan Dodge

Adjutant Cash shared a couple of slides with the membership and discussed several current topics:

- 1. The upcoming Mid-Winter virtual Department conference.
- 2. National Conference: No decision as of yet. Possibly in August
- 3. Dept of NC annual Conference: Unknown if this event will be held
- 4. Department Programs:
 - a. Oratorical: The Dept Oratorical contest will be held in Shelby, NC in March
 - b. Boys State: Possible virtual event
 - c. Girls State: Will be a virtual event
 - d. Legion Baseball: Unknown at this time
- 5. Insurance requirements: Resolution 35 passed in the Fall of 2020 indicates Posts need to add certificates naming National and the Department on their policies
- 6. Mission Blue Assistance: A program setup to offer grants to Posts. Posts need not have a building to qualify.
- 7. Suicide Awareness: The Department is setting up a Suicide Awareness Committee. Commander Hacker will serve.
- 8. Legion College: Will be moved to two sessions In November and December
- 9. Dept Staff: There is a new Media Coordinator

10. NC Veterans Council: Helps organize all veteran organizations across the State. They will be meeting next week to sponsor a suicide prevention committee.

Our 2nd guest speaker was Madilyn Smith from North Brunswick High School who was the winner of this years Post 68 Oratorical Contest. Madilyn gave her speech on the Constitution via a video that was played during this meeting.

Dale Todd, Post68 Oratorical chair along with several members offered constructive feedback on the speech that Dale will provide to the contestant. The District 9 Oratorical Contest is to be held this coming Saturday at St James Post. Only 2 Posts in the District are participating: 534 and 68.

4. **Oratorical Contest Results**: Dale Todd: Post 68 held it's annual Oratorical contest Jan 9th, 2021 at Blossoms Restaurant. Two contestants from North Brunswick High School participated. Many precautions were taken due to COVID-19 concerns. First place went to Madilyn Smith, a sophomore. Second place was awarded to Kaitlyn Shields a sophomore and JROTC Cadet. Both contestants delivered an original eight-to-ten-minute prepared oration on aspects of the U.S. Constitution, with emphasis on the duties and obligations of American citizens with Ms. Smith focusing on the Bill of Rights and Ms. Shields focusing specifically on the First Amendment's Free Speech clause. Each also delivered a 3-to-5-minute extemporaneous discourse on the assigned topic of Article III, Section 1 regarding the establishment of the Supreme Court. The Post presented Smith with a first-place check for \$500 and Shields with a 2nd place check for \$300. Both contestants received a medal and certificate. Smith will go onto the District 9 contest Jan 23rd.

5. Department Youth Programs Update: Dale Todd
